Major Responsibilities:

- Revise, update and communicate company procedures to reflect changes and improvements in operations
- Support company and contractor training efforts in the areas of pipeline Integrity and corrosion control, to ensure procedures are followed
- Support Quality and Standards in evaluating new products and/or processes
- Maintain Operator Qualification for task assigned to departments including Transmission Integrity Management Program, Distribution Integrity Management Program and Cathodic Protection.
- Maintain a safe work environment by following approved safety requirements and using company-issued safety equipment
- Plan and control work activities to help provide an accident-free workplace
- Troubleshoot defective materials and ineffective work processes
- Maintain a list of gas materials tested, approved, and rejected for submission to Procedures and Materials committee, and provide other administrative support
- Provide support to the procurement team in creating materials list
- Conduct random inspection of company and contractor storerooms to confirm stocked materials are approved for use in company gas distribution system
- Perform annual risk and threat assessments under distribution integrity program
- Prepare regulatory reports including damage to company facilities per guidelines
