## NGA ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT OF PRESIDENT & CEO JOSÉ COSTA

Mr. Costa has over 25 years of experience in natural gas utility operations, most recently serving as NGA's Vice President of Operations Services. He served as the Regional Manager Customer Relations with the Gas Research Institute (GTI Energy) and in utility operations at Colonial Gas Company, now part of National Grid.

He holds a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, and an MBA from the University of Massachusetts at Lowell. He earned the Certified Association Executive credential from ASAE in 2008.

In the announcement, Mr. Bradley expressed the Board's appreciation to Mr. Crews for his leadership at the NGA. While his tenure was brief Charles had a positive impact on the direction of the organization by leading the development of a new strategic framework. He noted that Mr. Crews will serve in an advisory position to the Board until his departure on November 30, 2022.
