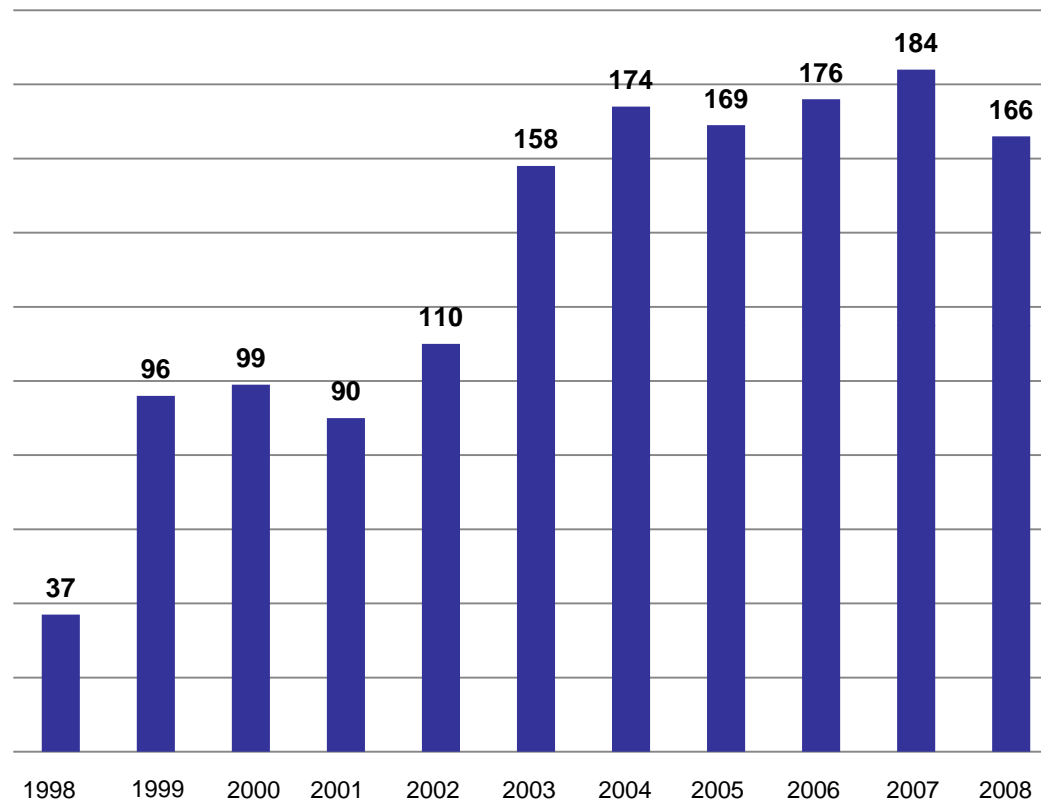


# Annual LNG Imports, New England

*Billion cubic feet (Bcf) per year*



New England has been a steady importer of liquefied natural gas (LNG) for decades. Annual imports since 1998 are shown in the chart above. All imports until 2008 are by the Distrigas facility outside Boston. In 2008, a new offshore LNG facility, Northeast Gateway, entered service; it represented just under 1 Bcf of imports in '08, while Distrigas took in 165 Bcf.
