Role and Scope of Position:

Plans, coordinates and provides supervision to Company and contractor personnel engaged in construction, operation and maintenance of the distribution system and production facilities in assigned area of the Company. Performs on-call duties as required.

Essential Functions:

- Plans, prepares, schedules and coordinates daily work assignments related to the construction, operations and maintenance of the distribution systems and production facilities, including job pre-check, supervision and monitoring of work progress. Reviews completed work assignments.
- Investigates job sites prior to crew assignment to determine crew sizing, special job requirements and job readiness, and verifies material availability.
- Assigns appropriate manpower, vehicles, and specialized tools and equipment to efficiently and cost effectively meet work requirements.
- Initiates and/or completes all documentation related to assigned work including verification of time and vehicle reports, sketches of completed work, leak reports and paving records. Verifies invoices related to contractor work.
- Examines and approves daily time and vehicle sheets; checks for correct completion of assigned work and to make sure proper accounting procedures are used.
- Obtains permits, arranges traffic control and initiates Call Before You Dig ("CBYD") notifications and reports related to assigned work.
- Contacts customers to ensure that jobs can be performed as planned/scheduled and that all requirements are satisfied.
- Prepares documentation for the generation of work orders, and prepares work orders.
- Implements approved employee safety programs and monitors employee and contractor work practices to assure compliance with Company and OSHA safety standards, and DOT compliance.
- Monitors third-party construction within the assigned area.
- Administers Company policies and procedures related to employee training, qualification of construction personnel, and other associated reports in compliance with State and Federal regulations.
- Plans, schedules and supervises the daily work assignments of assigned clerical and field technician staff.
- Administers the agreement between the Company and the Union.
- Schedules and monitors vehicle maintenance and repairs.
- Investigates and reports on customer damage claims and equipment failures.
- Assures work practices of assigned personnel follow all company safety standards and work practices.
- Performs Supervisor On-Call duties as required, including supervising field personnel engaged in emergency activities.
- Creates and maintains purchase orders with outside vendors.
- Reviews and approves operations related invoices for payment.
- Will have storm duty assignments.

Technical Knowledge/Skills: Must be able to pass Operator Qualification tests related to job. Thorough knowledge of gas distribution system and production plant operation. Thorough knowledge of construction, operating and maintenance practices, procedures, and standards. Working knowledge of applicable governmental codes affecting natural gas distribution and production. Working knowledge of accounting and business procedures. Familiarity with environmental requirements. Ability to operate

computers. Demonstrated ability to analyze serious gas distribution and gas production problems, determine solutions and take corrective action. Working knowledge of the Company-Union contract. Ability to plan, prepare, schedule, and effectively supervise the work of subordinates. Demonstrated leadership abilities, including ability to effectively provide work direction to assigned personnel according to established work practices, safety standards, and within provisions of applicable Company—Union Agreement and Eversource policies. Must possess excellent customer service skills.

Education /Experience: High School diploma plus 1-year technical training plus sixteen years related experience. Or, Associate's degree in applied sciences or the equivalent plus 12 years related experience. Supervisory experience preferred.

Licenses & Certification: Must hold a valid driver's license (CDL preferred).

Working Conditions:

Constantly exposed to gaseous atmospheres, high noise levels, and traffic, construction site hazards and hazards on customers' property.

Physical Aspects:

Other: Federal Operation Qualification requirements apply. This is a safety sensitive position and subject to random drug testing.

Responding to emergency situations to meet customers' needs is part of every employee's role. If employed, you will be given an Emergency Restoration assignment. This means you may be called to assist during an emergency outside of your normal responsibilities, work hours and location.
