This position will be responsible for coordinating and reporting on Iroquois Greenhouse Gas program. This program includes leak surveys required by regulations such as EPA's Subpart W and New York DEC's Part 203 regulations, maintaining all records and compliance coordination as required for these regulations. In addition, this position will coordinate Iroquois voluntary methane reduction programs, such as the EPA Star program, EPA Methane Challenge Program, and the Interstate Natural Gas Association of America (INGAA) Methane Reduction Commitments. This work will require the ability to schedule and coordinate between various consultants and Iroquois employees, track compliance, schedule repairs and prepare reports for Iroquois as well as various Agencies. Duties will include travel to facilities in New York and Connecticut and also may require travel to organizational meetings in other parts of the country.

Knowledge:

Working knowledge of federal, state, and local Greenhouse Gas regulations and commitments. Must have a working understanding of field surveys done for Methane Leak Surveys and what is involved in these surveys. Must have excellent writing and verbal communication skills, as well as excellent interpersonal skills. Must be highly organized and the ability to pay attention to details.
