Summary:

Under close supervision, provides analysis, planning, implementation and support of the technological needs and objectives of the Engineering, Operations, Right of Way, Environmental & Safety, and Drafting corporate functional unit. The major objective of this role is to improve business processes and to support critical business strategies. It provides development, reengineering, implementation, documentation, and maintenance of business applications systems and processes.

This position exists to provide the appropriate systems, applications and a level of technical support in order for the corporate functional unit to accomplish its business goals. This position must apply the most effective technology to the needs and objectives of the corporate functional unit.

- Extensive experience in project management for system design, development and support.

Periodic overtime may be required to support critical systems during emergency situations. This position also requires a good knowledge of the business and broad technical skills. In this position, the incumbent will interact daily with the business community and must have the ability to communicate effectively both orally and in written form. This interaction with the business community requires travel "out in the field" on a regular and "as required" basis.

Must be adaptable and be able to change direction quickly.
