To ensure the timely and accurate completion of all necessary records, timesheets, paperwork and documentation needed for accounting, regulatory, asset management and related purposes. Professionally interact with customers, regulatory authorities, and employees to ensure that the company satisfactorily meets their needs

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- 3 years of related field experience.
- Maine State Gas license.
- Must accept Company assigned standby on rotation basis.
- Must reside within the specified geographic call area and respond within 30 minutes to gas leak emergencies.
- Must be available for duties during times of system emergencies.
- Must be able to obtain Operator Qualification (O.Q.) certification based upon the requirements set forth in DOT 49 CFR 192, Subpart N.
- Posses a valid Class A Commercial Driver’s License within 24 months of employment.
