Incumbent provides technical leadership requiring extensive knowledge of gas pipeline regulations and other applicable codes and regulations; construction, operation and maintenance and transmission practices for gas pipelines, liquefied natural gas, and liquefied propane production facilities; operator qualification and training requirements; and recordkeeping and reporting requirements.
